An update from the university stated that the first day events were marked with essay writing and debate competitions on the topics 'Swadeshi: Understanding Gandhi's vision of selfreliance' and 'KVIC: Post liberalisation and globalisation in India.'

It stated that in the essay writing competition, Tsiikane Rollen Duomai
